SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

High standards and a positive work ethic are central to a successful future. Our school uniform creates a sense of belonging to our school community and sets the tone for all our work.

Students are required to be dressed as follows:

Short-term Placements

- Home school uniform

Long-term Placements

- Blain black shoes
- Plain black school trousers (no jeans/skinny's/cropped trousers)
- Plain black polo shirt with The Hub logo
- Plain black sweatshirt with The Hub logo

It is advisable that clothing is clearly marked with the student's name in case of loss.

We do not allow students to wear jewellery, except for one stud per ear for those with pierced ears. No other body piercings are allowed. Neither are ear plugs.

Hair should be clean and well kept - extreme or unusual styles and/or unnatural colours are not acceptable. The Headteacher will have the final decision on the definition of extreme/unusual/unnatural.
